

# What are the symptoms of COVID-19? It can vary from person to person.

COVID-19 affects different people in different ways. Infected people have had a wide range of symptoms reported – from mild symptoms to severe illness.

Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus.

People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- · Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- · New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Look for emergency warning signs for COVID-19. If someone is showing any of these signs, seek emergency medical care immediately:

- Trouble breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion
- · Inability to wake or stay awake
- Bluish lips or face

NJ only state to see cases drop for 2 weeks. What you need to know. (July 25, 2020)

State officials on Friday gave a better idea of what remote learning will look like for families who don't want to send students back to school in the fall due to concerns about the coronavirus.

As of Friday, New Jersey was the only state in the U.S. to see the number of new cases decline for the past two weeks, officials said. But, case numbers in recent days have been skewed by a nationwide delay in getting test results and by a reporting issue at Quest with lab results.
